2024 BISHOP'S FUND APPEAL REACHES GOAL

Through the generous support of more than 6,400 households across the diocese, the 2024 Bishop's Fund Appeal has surpassed its goal of \$1,330,000.

The Eucharistic Family

Popular Catholicism holds up the importance of domestic religious practice. One learns a powerful Eucharistic faith in the context of the home, discovering the way that the presence of Jesus and his mother, Mary, changes everything.

Retrieving a Eucharistic popular Catholicism necessitates, therefore, an emphasis on the family as the domestic church. When I say that the family is the domestic church, I want to emphasize three caveats.

1. To call the family the domestic church is not merely a helpful metaphor.

Rather, insofar as the family is a manifestation of divine communion in the world, a place where the love of Christ and the Church becomes present, the family is really and truly a domestic church. By its nature, the family is therefore Eucharistic, inviting every person to experience the love of Christ in the imperfect communion of husband, wife, and (God-willing) child(ren). The family, when gathered in prayer and blessing, or when remembering the feasts of the Church year, is an authentic manifestation of Christ's love for the world.

2. Because of the Eucharistic identity of the family as a space of communion in the world, we must avoid a romanticized account of the family.

Yes, the family has a vocation to guard love. Moms and dads are integral to this task, even if the domestic church is not reducible to what is often called the nuclear family. But a popular Catholicism recognizes that family life is complicated. It is not some angelic mode of existence, where children are always perfect, and moms and dads get everything right all the time. Otherwise, nearly every family I have encountered (especially my own) would be excluded.

3. The family is a domestic church in relationship to the concrete celebration of the Eucharistic mystery in the parish.

This means that the family must learn to become what is received in the Eucharistic mystery, a communion of love that exists for the life of the world. All that we have said about an integral Eucharistic formation in Chapter 3 is therefore important for the family. The memory, understanding, and desire of the family must be suffused with the Eucharist.
