The Diocese of Ogdensburg - is pleased to now be able to offer Naloxone training, commonly known as Narcan training, to our diocesan parishes, outreach centers and organizations.

Between 2019 and 2023, 396 residents of the Diocese of Ogdensburg and neighbors died of drug overdoses. Statewide, there were 6,330 overdose deaths during that period, an average of more than 1,500 per year. Data suggests those numbers continue to climb.

As Catholics, we recognize the sanctity of life from conception to natural death, and we work to save the lives of the unborn, the affirm, the elderly - everyone. We have an opportunity to learn to save more lives with this training.
