Since we, Ministers of the Eucharist, are not entering the church in formal procession but only going up to the altar to be of service and then to return to our seats, it is not necessary to approach the altar together or in procession.

When it is time to go up (a good time is during the sign of peace while there is movement in the church), each goes up from wherever they are sitting in church, and stand on the side back from the altar. When it is time to receive, step up to the priest. When your line has finished, you return the chalice to the altar. You do not need to wait for the other Eucharistic Minister to finish.

**Please be mindful that some of our servers would like to receive from the cup.** If they do not, they will return to the kneeler or be ready to assist with the communion paten.
